Award Goals

Criteria

Eligible partnerships must have been in place for at least **two years** and include

- * Participation of CEO or the chief regional officer
- * Donation of material resources
- * Three volunteer activities held during the course of the year.
- * Identifiable impact on students, staff, and/or school community.

**School-business partnerships can include: corporations, non-profits and government agencies as long as the criteria above is met.*

Nominations may be submitted by the partner or by the school. If you believe you meet the criteria set out above, we encourage you to fill out the attached form and return it to the below address, no later than **October 13, 2009**:
